## **Greetings members,**

What a difference a day can make in altering our daily lives. Sally rode into town and put a hammering on GLYC and all of us. The good news is that we are well insured and no one was injured or worse. We now have to begin the process to repair our club.

A review of damages indicate that our pier and marina suffered heavy damage and will need a complete rebuild. The property has major erosion on the south side, stair and railing damage to the main building, lower galley and minor ceiling damage, concrete walkway damage , and serious damage to our sail locker and storage building.

We have met with all of the insurance adjusters, and are waiting for follow up on loss estimates and monies available. We also have received a cash advance from Chubb to begin repairs. Since the dock is our biggest loss and most complex project , the BOD has decided to search for a management firm or restoration company to assist with the marina rebuild. If anyone has any suggestions on this please contact any Flag officer . The other needs will be coordinated by the Board with expected member support. We think that we can rebuild the Sail locker as well as effect repairs of the lower galley and other property needs separately. We hope to have the back stairs and railing fixed very soon. As you can imagine this will be a slow process. Everyone's patience and support will be required. Please look for opportunities to help with the rebuild of GLYC. We welcome any and all members with both talent and time to help out. And don't forget that we are open our normal hours, so please come visit your club and enjoy the view and our people.

The Board believes that we can and will survive this latest challenge and we will have a new and improved GLYC into 2021.

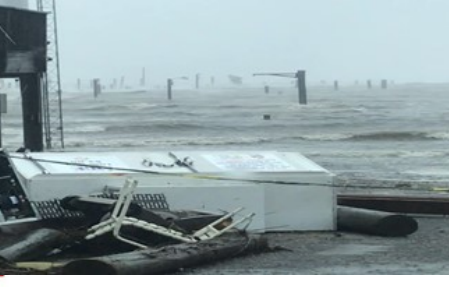

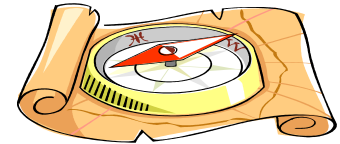

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# **GRAND LAGOON YACHT CLUB**

## **HOUSE RULES**

1. Register their guests and be accountable for their conduct. Guest MUST be accompanied by the house member.
2. Be appropriately dressed in the club. No bathing suits, tank tops, or bare feet in the clubhouse. Be at least casually dressed in good taste during the dining room hours.
3. Observe current opening and closing hours as posted.
4. Refrain from offensive language, conduct, or intoxication. (if offensive, a member may be asked to leave the premises by club management or on duty personnel and is expected to do so at once)
5. Refrain from going behind the bar or entering the galley during operation or otherwise interfering with bar/galley functions.
6. Purchase all alcoholic beverages to be consumed on premises from the bar.
7. Be accountable for the conduct of their children. Children are not allowed at the bar other than the service station for the purchase of soft drinks or other sundries. They must leave the area immediately after their purchase.
8. Refrain from littering on the premises.
9. Members are accountable for their pets and their conduct. Pets must be on a short leash and in designated areas at all times. Designated areas included downstairs, parking lot, and upper deck on the east side only.
10. Do not take club property (eg. glassware, china, silverware, etc.) beyond the dock.
11. Refrain from smoking, including e-tobacco products or “vaping”, or use of all other tobacco products inside the clubhouse.

### Members should be aware that:

1. These rules are enforceable by any board member, manager, or Flag Officer present.
2. Any previous member who has left The Club NOT in good standing cannot be a guest of another member.
3. Delinquency in financial obligations will result in denial of club privileges and possible expulsion from The Club.
4. Any complaints, requests, or suggestions must be directed to The Board in writing.
5. Violations of any of the above rules will result in action by the Board of Governors concerning the member(s) involved. The member(s) will be allowed a hearing and the Board of Governors action may be appealed. However, if the member(s) in question is on the Board, he/she will not be allowed to vote in the appeal.
6. Rules will be posted at all times.
