Hello All,

It's hard to believe that July is already upon us. **The marina is wrapping up**, and I must say that the What's Up Docks crew has done a great job, and with a minimal crew. The crew is now working on getting their equipment off of the property and setting the pilings for those who have ordered boat lifts. We are still waiting on the power company to set the transformer that will provide power to the Marina. The dock is certainly something to be proud of.

As far as boat slips are concerned, the west side is almost completely spoken for. The east side has only two spoken for. However, none of these slips have been contracted nor billed as of today. We ask that you let us know if you intend on occupying a slip for more than a few hours even though they are not all spoken for or billed. If anyone is interested in a slip, then let me know and I will pencil you in. **We are working on a new hurricane plan** which I hope that we will have ready in the next week or so and voted on in the July board meeting. We will also be putting together a plan to pay more strict attention to a few requirements that help protect our property and the property of others. If you have any questions, concerns or recommendations then please feel free to call me, or simply attend a board meeting on the third Monday of each month.

Unfortunately, the weather did not cooperate for the first attempt at the Hargraves Fishing Rodeo. We are rescheduled for July 16 & 17. The Captains meeting will still take place on the 15th with the fish fry and awards on the 18th. I believe that this was a blessing as the Marina should be completed and maybe we will have more participants.

As I said earlier, it's already July. We will need volunteers to be on the dock crew in case we need to prepare for one of those nasty storms. The boat dock preparation was made much easier with the installation of the flow through panels. However, there will be more items that we need to tend to. Please let me know if anyone feels that they can help out. **We will also be getting back to the normal clean up days. The next one will be July 2nd in preparation for the 4th.** I know this is a little different than the usual Saturday. I am thinking that the area will be super busy on Saturday the 3rd.

Before I close, I want to brag on the staff. They are doing an exceptional job and we are very lucky to have them. It is also very awesome to see the turn out of the members that we have had lately. Well, I am looking forward to seeing everyone at the upcoming events. As always, please do not hesitate to call on me if I can be of any assistance.

Hey, Everyone!

The weather has been ideal for sailing so far this summer, and we've had a lot of activity on the water!

The Sail Loft is completed and outfitted, and if you're interested in learning to sail, or want to use the Club boats, please give me a call and we'll set you up! We have several good Sunfish boats available, one "Mini-fish" for the more adventurous, and the Hobie Getaway if you'd like to go out with a group (up to 5-6 folks depending on their size). If you're interested give me a call!

Sail Camp is fast approaching and we have 21 young folks signed up, and almost the entire sailing committee and several others volunteering to instruct. We're looking forward to getting out on the water with these young folks (8-14 years old) on July 6, 7 and 8th. If you're interested in seeing how these young sailors are doing, you're welcome to drop by!

Raft UP! We're still trying to schedule the GLYC one-day raft up in Grand Lagoon! Due to scheduling conflicts we've had to move it a couple of times, and this time we're gonna try for **July 24, 2021 at 10 AM**. This raft up is for all power and sail boats that can make it across the lagoon to Redfish Point. Due to crowded conditions on the weekends we will stay well clear of the Ft McRee cove. Boaters can anchor in 2-3 feet of water, or beach their boats and wade out to the raft up. Power boaters will form the base of the raft up - all are reminded to bring plenty of fenders (and sunscreen)! The plan is to arrive mid-morning, have a leisurely lunch, and then return home by late afternoon. If the weather is inclement we will move the Raft Up back to a week in August.

Since GLYC has not had a Raft UP in several years, we want as many power boats and sail boats as possible. Any members that don't have boats, or much experience, that still want to participate, please sign up at the Club and we will try and match you up with available spaces on boats. Any boats with "extra seats" available, please also sign up at the Club, and we will try to fill your empty seats. This is a great way to get more people involved on the water, plus you may make some new friends at the club! Sign up sheets will be posted at the Club the first week of July.

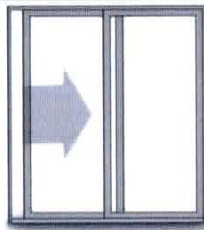

HOUSE RULES

1. Register their guests and be accountable for their conduct. Guest **MUST** be accompanied by the house member.
2. Be appropriately dressed in the club. No bathing suits, tank tops, or bare feet in the clubhouse. Be at least casually dressed in good taste during the dining room hours.
3. Observe current opening and closing hours as posted.
4. Refrain from offensive language, conduct, or intoxication. (if offensive, a member may be asked to leave the premises by club management or on duty personnel and is expected to do so at once)
5. Refrain from going behind the bar or entering the galley during operation or otherwise interfering with bar/galley functions.
6. Purchase all alcoholic beverages to be consumed on premises from the bar.
7. Be accountable for the conduct of their children. Children are not allowed at the bar other than the service station for the purchase of soft drinks or other sundries. They must leave the area immediately after their purchase.
8. Refrain from littering on the premises.
9. Members are accountable for their pets and their conduct. Pets must be on a short leash and in designated areas at all times. Designated areas included downstairs, parking lot, and upper deck on the east side only.
10. Do not take club property (eg. glassware, china, silverware, etc.) beyond the dock.
11. Refrain from smoking, including e-tobacco products or “vaping”, or use of all other tobacco products inside the clubhouse.

Members should be aware that:

1. These rules are enforceable by any board member, manager, or Flag Officer present.
2. Any previous member who has left The Club **NOT** in good standing cannot be a guest of another member.
3. Delinquency in financial obligations will result in denial of club privileges and possible expulsion from The Club.
4. Any complaints, requests, or suggestions must be directed to The Board in writing.
5. Violations of any of the above rules will result in action by the Board of Governors concerning the member(s) involved. The member(s) will be allowed a hearing and the Board of Governors action may be appealed. However, if the member(s) in question is on the Board, he/she will not be allowed to vote in the appeal.
6. Rules will be posted at all times.
